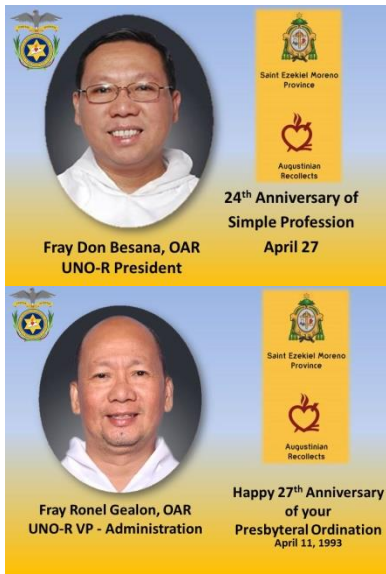

DEADLINE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF GRADES IS MAY 08

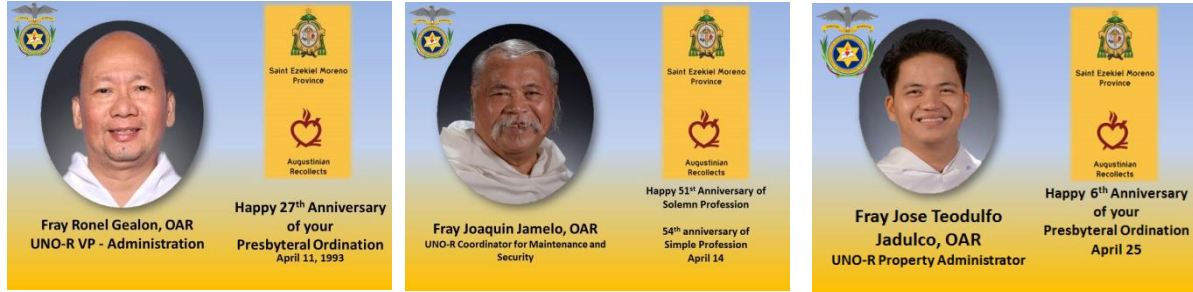

NEGROS OCC. DOWNGRADES ECQ TO MCQ; CITY IMPOSES STRICTER ECQ

The Governor issued an Executive Order modifying EO#20-20A . The new EO is for the gradual transition from the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) to General Community Quarantine (GCQ) starting April 20, 2020. The EO allows trisikad and tricycles to ply the routes within the municipalities and cities under Negros Occidental. Meanwhile, the City of Bacolod issues EO's for the stricter implementation of the ECQ. The Mayor ordered a lockdown on all remaining Sundays of the ECQ. No ECQ passes shall be honored on Sundays. The Mayor also ordered the odd-even scheme of the use of the ECQ passes. This developed in Bacolod for 2 more positive cases of COVID were reported.

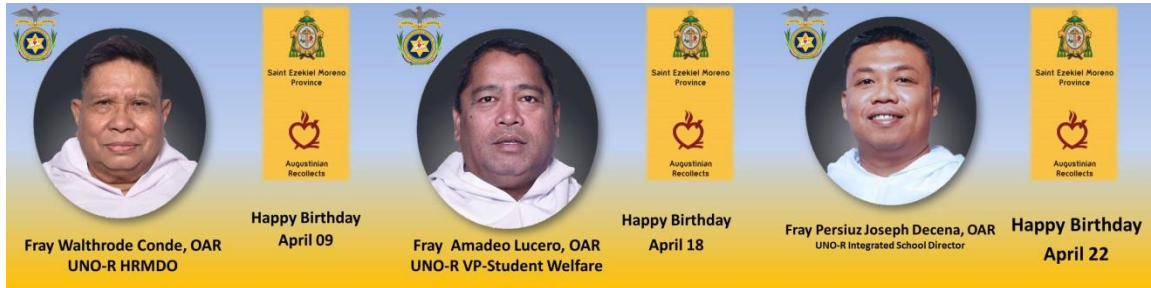
